

18. Blind Toss

Have students sit down in a circle. Place a mat on the floor with numbers and a flashcard (target vocabulary) on each number. Taking turns, each student gets blindfolded and tosses a beanbag so as to hit a number. S/he must call out that word the same number of times as the number indicates. For example: 4-dog, then "Dog, Dog, Dog, Dog!" and the student gets the equal points (4). At the end, the student with the most points wins! Good for memorizing vocabulary since they are repeating Word.
